What is PRFCT?

PRFCT lawns and landscapes are managed without the use of toxic, synthetic pesticides and fertilizers.

Why PRFCT?

1. For your family and pets: Landscape toxins are dangerous! They are linked to cancers, hormone disruption, autism, and Parkinson's Disease. They are especially harmful to children and pets.
2. For the environment: Landscape toxins pollute our drinking water and kill pollinators and wildlife.
3. PRFCT is easy, looks the same, and doesn't cost more!

How can that be?

What do I do?

Simple, here's how...

PRFCT How To:

1. Water seldom, water deep. 1–3× per week for at least an hour per zone. Check moisture depth. Frequent short watering promotes shallow roots, fungus diseases and mosquitos.
2. Mow high — 3.5" to 4" — leaf blades collect more sun/shade out weeds. Mow sharp — clean cuts are healthier. Leave clippings — free fertilizer.
3. Renovate, repair and feed in the fall: when cool season grasses are actively growing and warm season weeds—Dandelions and crabgrass—are dormant. In the spring there will be no room for them.
4. Don't overfeed: use slow release organics or compost/compost tea. Test your soil.
5. Promote diversity. It takes a village. Use mixes of resilient turf grasses and allow clover, which provides nitrogen.
